HISTORY

The first owner was Maurice Charles who purchased the yacht new in 2001 from the Bavaria Yachts factory in Germany. The yacht was first registered in Gibraltar and continued to reside there under the name Amanda Jayne until it was sold.

The second owner was the late Vic Locke who took ownership in March 2010 and moved the yacht from its base in Gibraltar to Hong Kong in November 2010. The yacht was licensed as Sirocco on 8th April 2011 with the Hong Kong Marine Department.

The current owner is Asia Pacific Yachting Ltd (APY) wholly owned by Cameron Ferguson and APY took ownership of Sirocco on 7th February 2014. For the last 11 years, Sirocco was the primary RYA sail training vessel for APY's RYA Recognized Training Centre delivering a wide range of yachting courses. During this period the yacht has been maintained to the highest standards and undergone numerous upgrades. Sirocco comes with an extensive set of equipment and is ready to set sail immediately.
